Dancing Achievement Award

These awards, at Intermediate, Advanced and Very Advanced levels, are intended for dancers who wish to improve their standard of dancing and to have that achievement recognised. The dancers must attend a training session/s of a minimum of 5 hours. Dancers must learn the set dances and other formations not included in those dances. This can be done at Summer School or locally by a Branch. The cost of the assessment is £20 (£16 for those under 25). Interview with Rod Purcell

When and where did you start Scottish Country Dancing?

Always liked dancing and did usual Ceilidh and simple dances at school in Uddingston and Hamilton. When we moved to England for work in 1980 we were going to try Ballroom but noticed in newspaper the inaugural meeting of Peterborough RSCDS; which we attended. Went to first dance 2 months later, did about half but were completely hooked.

Have you attended any dance events that you have particularly enjoyed?

Leeds festival with 40 sets dancing outside in the afternoon and many more in the refectory at night. Amazed at ~700 dancers in Bell's at our first Perth AGM.

What involvement have you had with the RSCDS, both at Branch level and at HQ?

Never had any HQ ambitions. Have served on branch committees and organized mass dancing at Expo Steam (Peterborough) and been Rhoda's support and bag carrier.

Do you have a favourite dance?

Falls of Rogie- it just seems to work. I still get a buzz out of any well timed strathspey - I am not really sure why that is.

- What would you like Perth Branch to do to encourage more dancers to join? I wonder if we had a young (teens/ twenties) teacher and could set up a class for young people, if that would get a new generation interested.
- What other interests do you have outside dancing?

I played the violin 20 years ago for a couple of years and have been having lessons for the last 2 years and have now started Grade V. I have even persuaded my teacher to use some Scott Skinner music. The grand children are great fun. I really enjoy cooking and unfortunately really enjoy eating.

- To provide, or assist in providing, special education or instruction in the practice of Scottish Country Dancing.
- To promote the enjoyment and appreciation of Scottish Country Dancing by any suitable means.
- Generally to do such things as are considered by the Local association to be incidental or conducive to the attainment of objects above stated.
